

MILWAUKEE AREA TECHNICAL COLLEGE DISTRICT STUDENT SENATE RULES

The Administration of the Milwaukee Area Technical College (hereafter referred to as MATC) establishes the following as the standing MATC District Student Senate Rules (hereafter referred to MATC DSS Rules).

The MATC DSS Rules are to help the meetings run smoothly and on time.

Putting new business before old business.

Putting new business before old business will help the meeting run on time.

Time Limits.

1. One comment per Senator.
2. One question per Senator will be asked.
3. Time permitting, after all Senators have made their comments and asked their questions will there be another comment and question asked with a time limit being set at the discretion of the Chair.

Use of technology.

Using technology (i.e. Skype, or telephone conference) voting is permitted only with prior approval by a member of the Executive Board and by the Director of Student Life 72 hours prior to the meeting for use of technology or conference calls.

Motions that have been tabled.

Motions that have been tabled, may be put on the next agenda, either at the end of new business or at the beginning of next agenda as old business.

Motions that have been tabled indefinitely will not be put back on the agenda. To address the issue a new motion would have to be made.
